- ✓ Address safety concerns at junction at Frampton Road Post office - Installed barriers to stop pavement parking and obtained funding for a controlled crossing.
- ✓ Seek out grant funding to contribute to the building of community centre within Penyrheol - Coming with the Gwynfaen Development in 23/24.
- ✓ Provide entirely new play equipment to parks in Penyrheol and Grovesend - Completely revamped both play areas totalling almost £170k.
- ✓ Work tirelessly to combat fly tipping and litter issues across the ward - participate regularly in community litter picks and report fly tipping
- ✓ Provide much needed additional defibrillators to key areas within the ward - Provided seven in the area since 2017.

COMMUNITY BUDGET | CYLLIDEB GYMUNEDOL

Using our community budget we have supported -

- Flower planters outside Penyrheol Post Office
- Wildflower and daffodil planting at key locations within the ward
- Helping local organisations such as Loughor RFC, Pengelli AFC, Penyrheol ABC, Moving Forward, Food with Friends and other community groups.
- Musical Equipment and balance bikes for Penyrheol Primary School
- Helped with the Gorseinon Hospital Garden Project



PARKS AND PLAY EQUIPMENT | PARCIAU AC OFFER CHWARAE

Your local Labour councillors are using the £2 million play fund so Penyrheol Ward gets the best parks and play spaces. We managed to secure significant funding to revamp Golden Grove play area and we would like to thank the Friends of Golden Grove Park for their excellent work on the initial fundraising, as well as Pengelli Primary for the in-depth consultation exercise and Grovesend Community Council for their support.

We are not going to stop there, we have also committed to supporting entirely new play facilities in both Loughor Foreshore and Parc Melin Mynach.

Working alongside neighbouring ward Councillors in Gorseinon and Loughor, as well as Llchwyr and Gorseinon Town Councils we have secured almost quarter of a million pound worth of investment into our local area.



SWANSEA'S COVID RECOVERY | ADFERIAD COVID ABERTAW

Your local Labour councillors have been here for you during the pandemic supporting communities to ensure people stay safe and well, delivering:

- 20 million items of PPE to keep staff and residents safe
- 10,000 hot meals to vulnerable residents
- We built the new bay hospital for our NHS in just 12 weeks
- Provided 10,000 IT devices so children could learn from home

The £20 million recovery fund to ensure our community, our residents and local businesses are supported to emerge stronger from the Covid pandemic. This includes:

- **Free bus travel** for everyone every Fri, Sat, Sun, Mon during holidays
- Free use of **parks and sports pitches**
- £10,000 grants provided for **local businesses**
- **Free public Wifi** in communities

NEW DEFIBRILLATORS | DIFFIBRILWYR NEWYDD

We said that we would provide much-needed defibrillators to key areas around the ward and we followed through on that promise. Thanks to the excellent support from HeartbeattrustUK and Cariad we have been able to place seven defibrillators within the ward over the last few years.



Three of these are in Grovesend & Waungron, an area that previously had very poor coverage.

In collaboration with colleagues in Gorseinon and Gorseinon Town Council, we also recently placed four new defibrillators at Penyrheol Community Church, Queensgate Village, Parc Y Werin and Chapel St.
